

Nanoverse Competition Official Rules

The Nanoverse: photo and photomicrography competition aim to promote the development of images taken by undergraduate and postgraduate students, professors, technicians, researchers, Brazilians or foreigners, using specials equipment (optical, digital, electromagnetic and others).

There are two categories: nanotechnology and nanobiotechnology.

Each entrant may participate in both categories.

No purchase necessary.

1. HOW TO ENTER

- (a) Submissions will be accepted from July, 19, 2023 to August, 1, 2023 at 11:59 p.m (GMT -3).
- (b) Access ENTRY FORM to upload the images.
- (c) Follow the instructions to complete the Nanoverse Competition entry form, including your name, email address, research project's name, image title, date, location, equipment specifications, lens, keywords (maximum of 5), if applicable, identify image processing software and describe it and research project's relevance.
- (d) Sign the assignment of image rights (available on ICONNANO website)
- (e) Important: The image submitted must not be awarded in other competition and, preferably, be unpublished. If the image was published previously in any scientific journal, the citation must be included in reference details. Adjust images will be accepted if those are not mischaracterized from the original one.

2. GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS

- (a) Images must be submitted in .tiff, .jpeg, .jpg or .png format.
- (b) Images should be submitted with highest quality with 10 MB file size at maximum
- (c) The submission must be in Portuguese or English language
- (d) Each entrant may upload a maximum of two (2) images by category



3. PRIZES

There will be three (3) winners ranked from first (1st) place through third (3rd) place, each one will get Honorable Mention prizes and Certificate.

Additionally, the first place in both categories will be awarded with One Thousand Brazilian Reais (R\$ 1,000.00).

4. WINNERS

The winners of the Competition will be announced on ICONNANO. There will be a ceremony (in-person) to deliver the honorable mention to the winners.

5. COPYRIGHT

- (a) The authors of the awarded images will be responsible for sending the original copy of the signed image rights assignment.
- (b) ICONNANO will have the right to use or not the images, in whole or in part, for printing and other purposes of scientific dissemination.
- (c) The authors reserve the right to present the images in exhibitions, meetings, conferences and allow their dissemination by the press or any other means, without commercial purposes, indicating, however, the prize awarded by ICONNANO.
